- Overall, the event raised **\$86,859** against our \$95,000 target goal, an amazing accomplishment thanks to your generosity and participation.

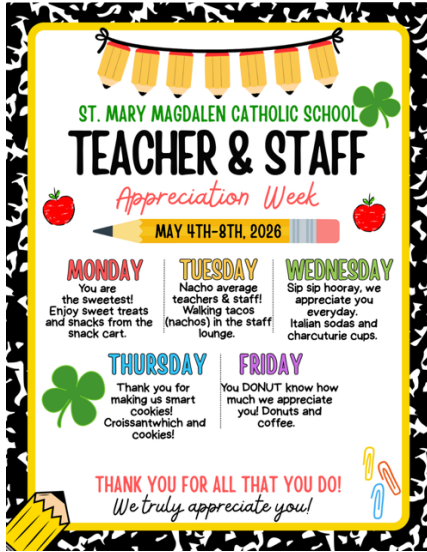
Every dollar raised directly supports our students and enhances their school experience. Thank you for making this event such a success and for continuing to show up for our school in such meaningful ways.
